Tips to Upper Fraser Valley Crime Stoppers lead to arrests and property seizures

Chilliwack, B.C. (October 30, 2020): Anonymous tips provided to Upper Fraser Valley Crime Stoppers have led to several arrests so far this year.

Police have made six arrests and have laid a total of six charges based on information provided to them through these tips.

The information passed on to local investigators by Upper Fraser Valley Crime Stoppers has also led to the recovery of \$116,775 worth of property, cash and drugs.
